Many of our services will continue over the phone, by video conferencing or through telehealth. In order to serve all of our clients, we need correct information to contact you. Important information about Klamath Falls services includes:

- Project Changes: Our team working in the KCS D schools will coordinate with district staff to offer services and reach out to youth working with Project Changes after spring break. Email Project Changes at projectchanges@lcsnw.org for more information.
- Medication Management: We will continue to serve clients with prescription refills through Kim, our Medical Assistant. You can contact Kim at 541-539-4964 or ktrailer@lcsnw.org
- WRAParound: We will continue to serve clients through phone and telehealth sessions. The WRAP team will set up these sessions with each client. The 24-hour access line is still available to clients.
- Substance Use Treatment (Drug Court): We will still serve clients through phone and telehealth sessions. Counselors will set up sessions with each client.
- Mental Health: We continue to serve clients with phone and telehealth sessions that counselors will set up with each client.
