Lutheran Community Services Northwest (LCSNW) is offering a 40-hour state-approved peer support and community health worker program for refugees and immigrants. After completing this training, participants will be eligible to become state-certified Peer Support Specialists and work as Traditional Health Workers in Oregon. The curriculum covers a range of topics, including:

- refugee-specific emotional health promotion
- education and peer-to-peer emotional support
- how to decrease stigma
- self-care and coping skills
- psycho-education
- patient navigation and care coordination
- advocacy across service systems
